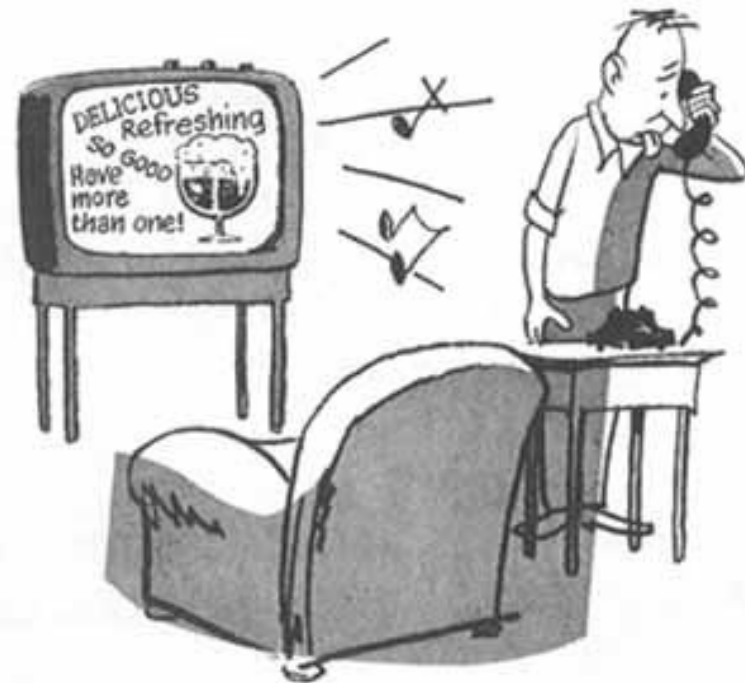
A.A. Central Office Announces New Office Manager
