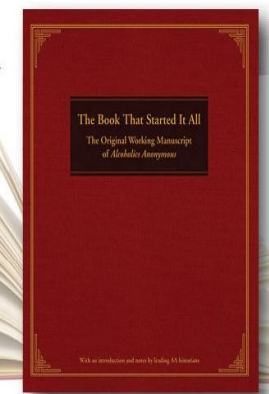
The tickets are \$1 each. They can be purchased at the Central Office on Old Hammond Highway or at the Big Book Study.
