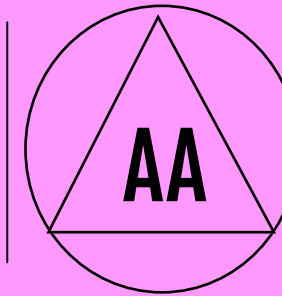

AA FINANCES

The following was presented by past delegate Bobby Broussard at the AA/Alanon Fellowship of the Spirit South event in Lafayette on April 11, 2015:

In 2013, the total operating budget for the AA General Service Office (GSO) was \$13 million. Of this amount, \$6.9 million (53%) came from group contributions, and the balance from literature sales. Only 43% of the groups made contributions.

As a reference point, there are 64,700 groups in the USA and Canada with a total membership of 1.424 million. The suggested allocation of group funds (after expenses) is 60% to the Central Office, 30% to the GSO, and 5% each to the Louisiana Area Assembly and the Capital Area Service Committee.
