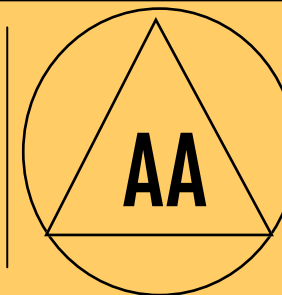

2015 CENTRAL OFFICE BIG BOOK STUDY REPORT

Presenter Chris R. did an outstanding job in carrying the AA message at this year's Big Book Study! Attendance was higher than expected, with 378 registered attendees. Some came from Florida, New York, Georgia, and South Carolina, as well as from all over Louisiana.

Donations for this event from the AA Community totaled just over \$2,100, and profit on book sales was about \$140. Expenses for the event totaled just over \$3,520, resulting in a net cost to the Central Office of approximately \$1,270.

Thanks to the many volunteers who made this event possible by donating their time and hard work, as well as many who donated food and supplies. These include the volunteers who worked the registration table, hospitality room, and book sales tables. Thanks to Darrell C, Member-At-Large for heading up the Central Office Committee oversight of the event, and to all COC Members who were on hand during the event to help wherever needed.

Special thanks to Randy R. who provided a wonderful jambalaya lunch for everyone at no cost to the Central Office.

Lessons for Red Stick Round-Up from the LA State Convention

The Louisiana recovery community turned out in force to support the state convention this past weekend. Over 600 souls* attended, which is remarkable given the many competing recovery activities in July, not the least of which was the International Convention just a few miles down I 85.
