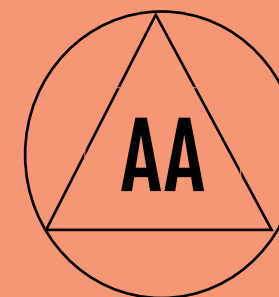

Gearing up for Red Stick Round-Up

Red Stick Round-Up will be "The Happening in Recovery" in mid-January 2016. That seems a long way off, given that we have to run the gauntlet of Christmas, the New Year, the NCAAF play-offs, and the Saints absence from post-season play. Here are a few things you can do in the run-up to the convention.

- Pre-Register on-line or by snail mail, and get a free lanyard.
- Buy T's, caps, and cups there too
- Encourage sponsees to sign up for Service Work; that's why we have a Round-Up!
- Donate to the scholarship fund by buying RSR Pre-Raffle Tickets
- Buy banquet tix to help to fulfill our contractual obligation to Crowne Plaza
- Dust off your group banners and get them to us e.g. via Central Office, or CASC

The Pre-Raffle First prize is a two-night stay at Cr Plaza for two, plus a pair of Banquet Tix, plus a pair of Registrations. Second prize is the Banquet Tix & Registrations, and Third Prize is the Registrations alone. We have printed only 400 tickets.

The banquet at \$39 looks pricey, but please do remember that's an all-in price, including hotel gratuity & service charges. It would be only a \$30 meal if it was on the hotel menu. That's a bargain for a four-course gourmet meal, not to mention the "priceless" opportunity to meet the speakers.

We will do a cost-cutting exercise that will "match your contributions" to the fund-raisers. We will eliminate all the non-essential items that we can find e.g. by minimizing hotel rooms for committee members. Four fewer rooms will save us \$1000. That's about the same dollar amount as your contributions via the Pre-Raffle and the T-Shirts sales.

And finally, some food for thought.... Nothing ever happened in the past, and nothing will ever happen in the future. Everything happens in the Now. (If that sounds familiar, it's because the very same sentiment is embodied in "One Day at a Time").
