What is a PCA (Pre-Conference Assembly) & Why is it important?

The Pre-Conference Assembly is held every April and all members of the A.A. Fellowship are invited to participate. This Pre-Conference Assembly’s primary purpose is to discuss the agenda items of the current General Service Conference (which is usually held in April in New York) and to inform the delegate of the Area’s group conscience, thoughts and experience on the Agenda items that will be before the Conference Delegates at that year’s conference.

What happens at a PCA?

Attendees of the conference are divided into session that include mock conference committees just like the delegates are at the actual conference. There, they discuss in detail the agenda items that the delegates will be discussing and voting upon when they go to New York. There will also be a general sharing session, so that area members can hear and perhaps give their opinion on agenda items in other sessions. Keep in mind that the delegate will go to conference and vote their conscience on behalf of AA as a whole, not just our area. However, it is important for them to consider the voices of area AA members. The entire purpose of the PCA is to better inform our delegate of the conscience of all AA members, since we are the owners of AA. As Concept 1 states:
Final responsibility and ultimate authority for A.A. world services should always reside in the collective conscience of our whole Fellowship.
