Committee Corner - Treatment & Corrections Committee

The Treatment and Corrections Committee (T&C) is one of the committees of the Capital Area Service Committee (CASC). It serves to coordinate bringing AA meetings to those who cannot leave their facilities to attend them.

On the state (area) level these are separate committees serving the incarcerated (state prisons & parish prisons/jails) and those in treatment centers. For the metropolitan area, these two groups are combined. The committee maintains a list of opportunities for service. Each facility has its own rules for who is permitted to visit for a meeting, and the committee maintains a list of contacts. Generous funding from CASC allows those bringing meetings to also bring conference-approved literature to the meetings for distribution.
