As Al-Anon's preamble to the twelve steps and traditions says, "<u>Al-Anon</u> is not allied with any sect, denomination, political entity, organization or institution. It does not engage in any controversy, neither endorses nor opposes any cause.

Likewise, <u>Alcoholics Anonymous</u> does not lend it's name to outside organizations, such as professional treatment facilities. You might see advertisements for <u>treatment programs</u> that claim to be "12-step based," but you won't see any that say they are affiliated with A.A.
